



Acknowledgement of Refund Policy

ManKind Project South Central 501(c) (3) is a non-profit organization that sponsors the New Warrior Training Adventure Weekend (NWTa). This training requires months of preparation, logistics and the expenditure of funds for the maintenance of the facilities, food, and materials, along with employing MKPI Certified Leaders and Co-Leaders to direct your weekend. To cover these costs, tuition for the NWTa is \$650. In addition, MKP SCA has limited accommodations for the NWTa as we offer an intimate, personalized experience. If you enroll and then cancel, we may have denied another man the opportunity to participate for the weekend. Tuition is to be paid prior to arriving at the weekend. Men usually pay the entire tuition when they register. Our refund policy is as follows:

Up to 24 hours prior to the NWTa - Refund: If you request a refund, in writing, from MKP SCA up to 24 hours before the NWTa for which you enrolled, you will receive a full refund of all you have paid to MKP SCA.

(No notification) Do Not Show Up for the Weekend - : If you fail to attend the NWTa for which you enrolled, and did not notify MKP SCA, you will be refunded all monies paid minus a \$150 deposit that can be applied to another training for up to one year.

Do Not Complete the Weekend : If you do not complete the weekend you must submit in writing a request for a full refund of your paid tuition no later than 7 days after the Sunday of the weekend. Request should be emailed to Areadirector@southcentral.mkp.org

Complete the Weekend and Want a Refund: If you remain and complete the NWTa through the Sunday Closing Ceremony, and you are not satisfied and want your money back, you will receive a full refund of your paid tuition, provided that:

1. Your tuition is paid in full, or all financial agreements have been met, prior to the Training.
2. You attend the entire Training (Friday evening through the Sunday Closing Ceremony.)
3. You have submitted a written request for refund, stating the reasons for your dissatisfaction, within seven days of completing the Training to the Area Director.
4. You have completed an exit interview with a Weekend Leader or an Elder before leaving the site of the Training.
